1.) What did the states want to gain by having the Articles of Confederation?
The states wanted to ensure that they each had their own freedom, independence, and a strong friendship.
2.) What was the major problem with the Articles of Confederation and taxes?
Congress had no powers to pass laws to collect taxes.
3.) What was a major weakness of the Articles of Confederation?
This type of government had only one branch.
4.) Why did Shay's Rebellion take place?
Farmers that fought in the war were owed money, but were still expected to pay property taxes.
5.) What did the Northwest Ordinance of 1787 proclaim?
It claimed that the larger territory should be divided into smaller territories.
6.) What were some of the guidelines that the Northwest Ordinance provided?
The Northwest Territory shall be divided into smaller territories; Governors and judges were appointed to govern the new territories; and slavery was not allowed in the new territories.
7.) What was the original purpose of the Constitutional Convention?
They originally wanted to fix and edit the Articles of Confederation.
8.) Why did the New Jersey plan supporters disagree with the Virginia Plan?

The Virginia Plan would give most of the power to the larger states.

9.) What was the Great Compromise?

There would be equal representation for each state in the senate; the House of Representatives would be based upon population; and that Congress would have two separate houses.

10.) What was the outcome of the Constitutional Convention?

The Articles of Confederation were replaced by the Constitution.

The preamble aims to protect the liberties of the citizens.
